

Scope of Services:

*Labour Market Research & Analysis

- 1. OTEC will conduct primary and secondary research to "take the pulse" of the current labour market issues facing local employers in your region.
- 2. OTEC will develop two surveys, one targeting employment service providers/education/workforce planning boards, and one targeting employers.
- 3. OTEC will distribute, coordinate and monitor survey responses from regional stakeholders. It is recommended that engagement in the survey work be supported by the regional lead to maximize uptake.
- 4. OTEC will analyze survey responses and integrate into Labour Market Analysis Summary Report.
- 5. This labour market research and analysis will take place at least six weeks prior to the facilitated stakeholder consultation meeting.

Stakeholder Consultation, Strategy and Partnership Development

- 1. OTEC will facilitate one full day, in-person, stakeholder consultation meeting to validate research findings, facilitate a review of existing resources, best practices and gaps; identify short, medium and long-term opportunities to address identified priorities; validate workforce development stakeholder ecosystem; confirm funding models and identify potential partners' roles in a sector-based strategy.
- 2. OTEC will analyze findings from stakeholder consultations and develop a set of strategic priorities/recommendations, incorporating promising practices from the region that will address the identified gaps between demand and supply side stakeholder groups.
- 3. OTEC in partnership with the regional lead will develop a Strategic Priority summary report based on stakeholder consultations and develop a partnership agreement with identified formal partners.
